Our Mandate

The NHICC mandate includes the following:

1. Establishing and maintain an independent national certification program for home inspectors and property inspectors in Canada.
2. Identify relevant training/education for home and property inspectors based on their ability to successfully complete a National Home Inspector Exam and Test Inspection.
3. Represent and promote the interest of Canadian home and property inspectors earning National Home Inspector designation.
4. Establishing and maintaining the status of a National Home Inspector with consumers, governments, and all stakeholders across Canada.

The classes of members that the corporation is authorized to establish.

Class A member include Directors and Registrant Representatives.

Class B member include Applicants, Provisional, National Home Inspectors, Public, Retired and Honourary Member.

The corporation is authorized to establish Class A members and Class B members as follows:

- (1) The Class A members shall be entitled to receive notice of and to attend all meetings of members of the Corporation and each Class A member shall have one (1) vote at each such meeting, except for meetings at which only members of another class are entitled to vote separately as a class.
- (2) Except as otherwise provided by the Canada-Not-For-Profit Corporations Act, S.C. 2009, c23 the Class B member shall not be entitled to receive notice of, attend or vote at meetings of the members of the Corporation.
